

# The Metre Square Dig Sunday 4 August 2013

*(date 4 August 2013)*

This is an initial note of the dig. The 'finds' are yet to be catalogued. Three 1-metre holes were dug and pottery, glass and bones found. Probably the most interesting find was uncovering (what appears to be) the corner of the Mill building owned by John Wight in the 1820s. The mill in 1820 was a main employer in the Sheepscombe Valley. Fifteen people enjoyed a days digging and some fine cakes and flapjacks, even in the light drizzle which fell at times
